- Energy future: Clean, diversified sources






Alaska Development



- Important safety and environment issues






Alaska Federal Onshore and Offshore Oil and Gas



- BLM Alaska
 - 75 million surface acres
 - 220 million subsurface acres
- 2010 USGS Assessment NPRA
 - 826 million barrels oil
 - 52.8 TCF gas



- BOEMRE Alaska
 - 670 active offshore leases
 - 1.5 million acres under lease
- 2011 USGS Assessment OCS
 - 1-10 billion barrels of oil
 - 6-100 TCF gas






