

#### Canyon Express — Deepwater GOM


~\$145 million operating cash flow through first 3 quarters of 2003

  - Drill additional prospect(s)




Falcon Nest 400 Mmcfpd capacity

 ~\$145 million in operating cash flow from the past two quarters




#### Challenges for Independents in Alaska

- Overall, a Challenging Environment to Achieve Investment Returns


