

Acquisition of Shell GOM assets.


Natural Gas Distribution:

"Measured Approach"...






- Design driven by shipping commitments
- 36-inch, 2500 psi, 2.6 bcf/d
- Reduced magnitude
- Lower project risk
- Gas one year earlier
- Better match with take with takeaway capacity
- Expandable to 6⁺ bcf/d based on exploration

Off takes and Additional Supplies...



- Ongoing evaluation
- Alaska
 - Anchorage Spur Line: 0.25 bcf/d to 1.2 bcfd
 - NGL extraction cost minimization
 - Options for smaller volumes
- Yukon
 - Locations / options
- Tariff structuring



Market Participation...



- Preliminary meetings held with some of the larger MidWest / Ontario LDCs
- Positive reaction to potential longer term capacity and supply commitments
 - Seeking dialogue with producers / state
- Willingness to overcome regulatory challenges
 - Enbridge & Duke submission to Ontario Energy Board
 - Facilitating broader coordination / cooperation
- Potential to be significant
 - Combined with producer and state commitments will define initial size of line required


