What Needs to be Done

- 1. Require federally registered apprenticeship programs on public works contracts and increase ratio of apprentices to journeyman
- 2. Increase funding to STEP program
- 3. State of Alaska to implement it's own apprenticeship programs

- 4. Support Alaska Works Partnership Programs "Apprentice Rural Outreach" and "Helmets to Hardhats"
- 5. Support School-to-Apprenticeship, Career Pathways and Voc-Ed
- 6. Require registered apprenticeship and training on large lease or development projects

- 7. Expand competitive bidding requirements for public works projects
- Labor needs to open up access to their programs
- 9. Consider a partnership with labor
- 10. Make commitment to hire Alaska workers
